Sir,

With reference to your letter No. MED/1093/CR.187/93-
EDU dated 31.3.94 on the subject cited above, I am directed
to say that the report of inspection of the colleges has been
considered by the Executive Committee of the Central Council
in its meeting held on 5.8.94 and it decided to grant
permission to Konkan Education Society's Chandrakant Hari
Keluskar Homoeopathic Medical College, Alibag and Vengurla
Homoeopathic Medical College, Vengurla to start BHMS Direct
Degree Course for two years from the date the concerned
University grants affiliation to them subject to the conditions
namely:-

- the admission in I-BHMS shall be restricted to 50
students only;
- admission to I-BHMS shall be made only after getting
affiliation from the University; and
- both the colleges shall make up the insufficiencies
as pointed out by Central Council and shall provide
the minimum requirements, norms and standards in terms
of accommodation, equipment, teaching as well as
hospital staff and attached training hospital as per
Homoeopathy (Minimum Standards of Education)
Regulations, 1983.

It is, therefore, requested that the State Govt. may
ensure that the colleges fulfill the above conditions and
the extent to which the colleges have made the progress may
please be informed to this Council within three months from
receipt of this letter. The insufficiencies observed during

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inspection are being intimated separately. Matter regarding
further recognition of the colleges will be considered by this
Council after receipt of a fresh request from the colleges
through State Govt. or the University.

Homoeopathic Medical College, Alibag, Dist. Raigad-402 201- regd.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC(MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. Further, as per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC(MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fails to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in existing Courses.

2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, CCH has conducted the inspection of K.E.S.'s Chandrakant Hari Keluskar Homoeopathic Medical College, Alibag, Dist. Raigad-402 201.. on 09.06.2016 and furnished the recommendation of CCH for granting permission to take admissions during A.Y. 2016-17 in existing Courses, subject to removal of the following deficiencies:- "Professor not appointed in Pharmacy and Repertory, Reader Not Appointed in Organon Medicine and Materia Medica. MoU with Super-specialty Hospital of Modern Medicine not available".

3. In this regard, an opportunity of hearing was given to the college on 6.10.2016. After considering the provisions of HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the CCH, observations of Hearing Committee and policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2016-17, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to K.E.S.'s Chandrakant Hari Keluskar Homoeopathic Medical College, Alibag, Dist. Raigad-402 201, for continuing admissions in BHMS course with fifty (50) seats for the academic session 2016-17 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st December, 2016 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2017-18:

- the college shall obtain the NABH accreditation for the Hospital within one year and the NAAC accreditation for the College within two years from the issuance of the permission letter and the college shall submit its compliance to this Ministry as well as to the CCH within specified period;

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ii. all the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2013" by 31st December 2016 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, all the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31st December, 2016, shall be denied permission from academic year 2017-18 onwards and action as envisaged under section 19 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 12A, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials"; and

iii. all the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

4. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the specified time period and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCH also. The CCH will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2017-18.

5. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by December, 2016 for continuing admissions during the subsequent years. CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for continuing admissions during the Academic Year 2017-18 and furnish the recommendations to the Central Government.

6. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
