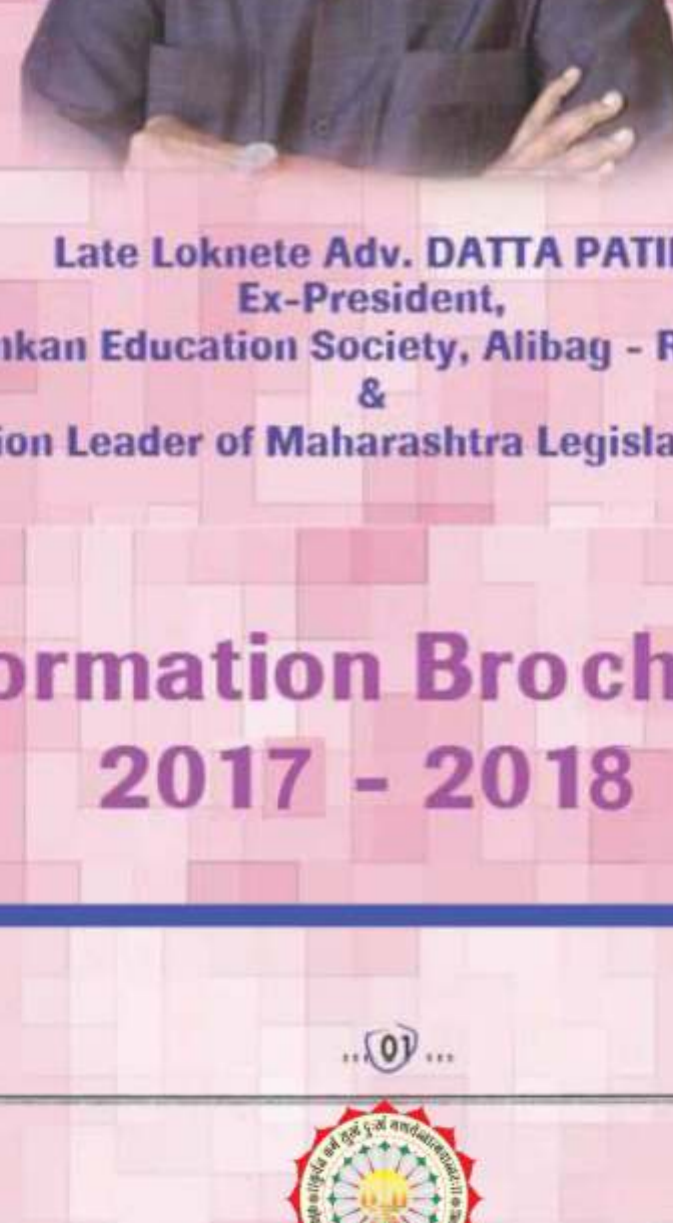




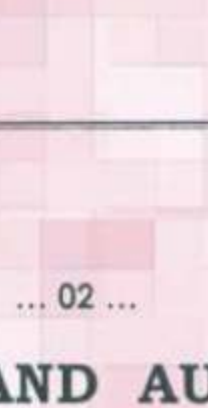

- ⇒ Appearing in the Internal Assessment Exams / Study Tour / Seminars which will be organised as per the University Syllabus time to time; during the academic year is compulsory.

- ⇒ The students must be punctual & attentive in the class & Practicals. **80% attendance** is compulsory for all Lectures & Practicals. Total working days for students are **265 days** in which Sports meets, Cultural days, Annual Social Gathering & Study Tour includes.

#### Fees :

1<sup>st</sup> Term : 1<sup>st</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> December.
